

Windsor Elementary Rules of Use for Shooting Star

The following list of rules is for the benefit of Shooting Star Coaches, Players and Families and the Schools we play in. The basic principle for Shooting Star is that we are guest in the facilities we are permitted to use and we treat them accordingly. We would to leave them in a better condition than we find them and we want to be as cooperative as possible with the Staff who operate these facilities.

1. Primary purpose of players to be in the facility is for practice or a game. If a player or family member is not on School property for a Shooting Star purpose then they should not be in the facility or on the grounds.
2. Players are to remain in the Gym and/or entrance areas at all times. No player or parents are to be in other school areas at any time when in the school. Players are to bring water bottles not be in corridors getting drinks and Windsor Elementary students are to have indoor footwear with them, not go to their classes to footwear.
3. Balls are NOT to be bounced or passed around outside of the gym.
4. No outside footwear is to go into the gym area, including washrooms and stage areas of gymnasium.
5. Shooting Star activities should start and end as designated in the schedule. All players and coaches should be out of the building 15 minutes prior to the departure of Janitorial Staff. Staff leave most evenings at 9 pm.
6. Players should not be on the floor until a coach arrives in the gym, even with a parent.
7. Washrooms are to be used by one player at a time and are not to be used as places to congregate by multiple players. This applies to player siblings as well.
8. Windsor Elementary equipment is not to be used for Shooting Star purposes. This includes any items on the stage area. Siblings of players should not be sitting, rolling or jumping on gym mats or bouncing balls during practice/games.
9. Shooting Star encourages parents to remain in the gym during practices. Siblings should not be unattended regardless of age and even if the sibling is part of another Shooting Star program.
10. The Stage curtain should be drawn closed during shooting Star practices and games. No one is permitted behind the curtain. Any necessary benches or chairs can be retrieved but only once coaches have permitted.
11. The Stage can be used to sit on the edge and one row of seating in front of the curtain. It is not to be used a play area for younger children.
12. There should be a parent volunteer designated to cover the door during Shooting Star home games. This is to ensure these rules are adhered to when Shooting Star is hosting a home game at Windsor elementary.
13. Windsor Elementary Staff should feel comfortable to approach any Shooting Star Volunteer and Coach to have concerns addressed.
14. There is absolutely NO SMOKING on Windsor Elementary Grounds or any school grounds that Shooting Star uses or visits to play away games.
15. Shooting Star coaches and Windsor Elementary staff are to ensure these rules are adhered to, any issues should be reported immediately to the other party. Shooting Star parents and coaches should assist in any way possible if a mess is made. The facility should always be left in better condition than it was found.
